River Oyster Project

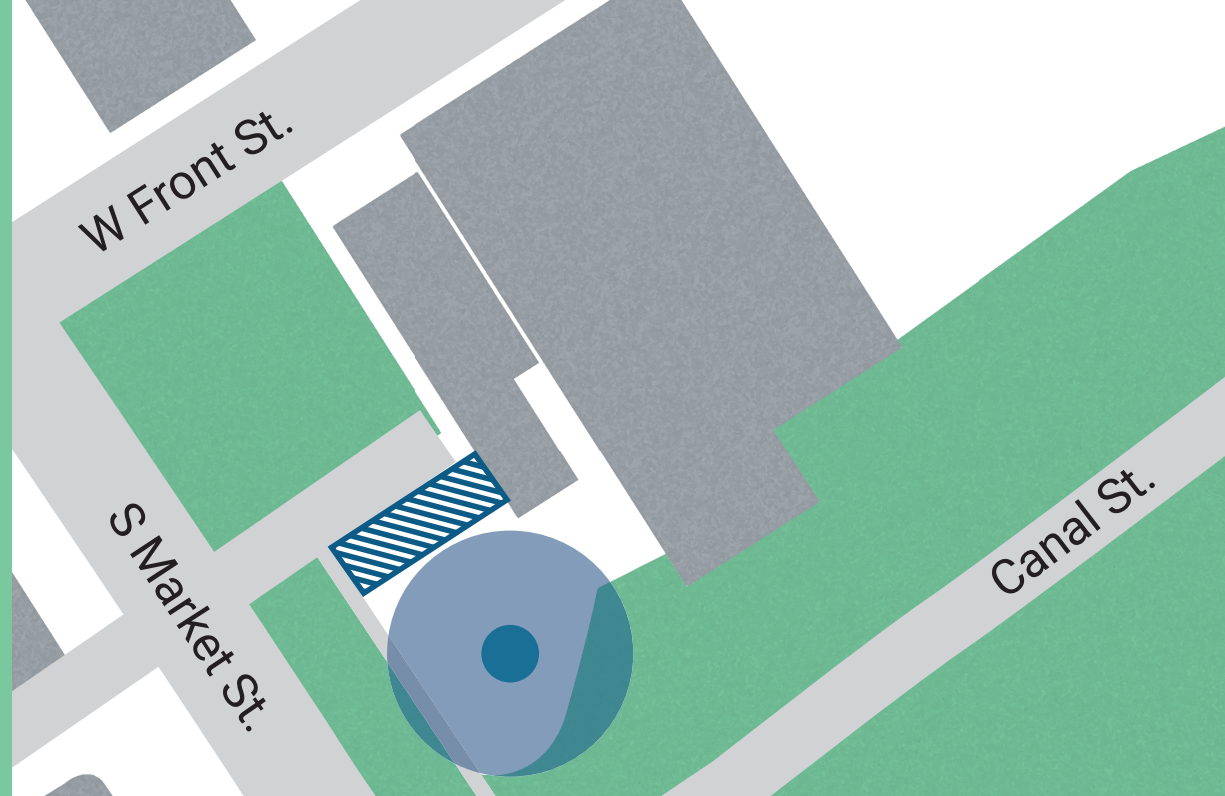
